STATUTE ABSTRACT

Art.5 (members' requirements)

ArtGallery accepts ad members people living in Italy or in foreign countries, without distinction of sex, race, political and religious beliefs, who share goals and statute principles of the association.

The Association's Executive Council constantly updates the member list Members can read at request the member list.

Art. 6 (admission, rights and duties of the members)

The admission of the members is free, provided that it's in keeping with the aim of the association. The Executive Council deliberates the acceptance of the admittance of the new ordinary associates. The application form must contain the commitment to observe this statute, the internal regulations and the decisions of the Executive Council.

Applicants will be notified in case of rejected application forms.

Minor applicants must provide an application form signed by a parent or guardian

Membership starts from the date when the application has been received.

Memberships never expires and is valid if the annual registration fee is paid. Right of withdrawal is admitted until 31st October of every year and it will be valid for the next year.

Withdrawal must be communicated by a return receipt letter, attesting the date of shipping.

Membership is valid through the payment of the registration fee decided by the executive council year by year.

Membership guarantees to the associate of age the right to vote in the ordinary and extraordinary assembly and the right to candidate for the election of the corporate bodies' members.

art. 7 (Member categories)

a) Founding members: Angela D' Amelio, Angelo Blancato, Benedetta Blancato e Federico Blancato.

b) Meritorious members are everyone that have helped the association through remarkable donations or who have endowed the association. They are nominated by the Executive Council.

c) Honorary members are all those members who excel in the field of art and culture and who are very representative in the association. They are nominated by the executive council.

d) Honorary members are all the members who meet requirements stated in the articles 5 and 6.

The above mentioned categories doesn't imply any difference of treatment concerning the members' rights and duties toward the Association. Honorary members can attend the Association's meeting but they don't have right votes.

Art. 8 (moral duties)

Joining the association is free and voluntary. Members have to respect this statute and the decisions of the Executive Council, by virtue of Statute competences.

Associates must have a proper conduct both with members and non-members and have to refrain any act that could damages the association.

Art. 9 (expulsion)

The Executive Council will decide the expulsion of members that don't respect the statute, the potential regulations and the decisions of the executive council. Members responsible of major infractions or who damage the name of the association will also be expelled.

Art 10 (losing of the member status)

The member status can be lost for the following reasons:

resignations; forfeiture of some of the member requirements; expulsion; delay of payment for more than one year; death.
